## Enhanced Content

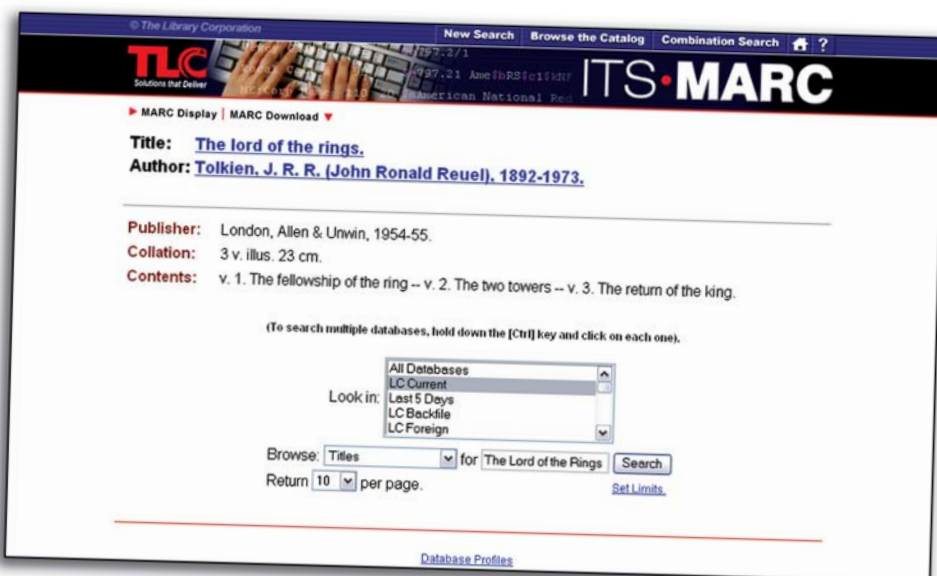
